

## Course Overview

Each 2 1/2 -hour class session is devoted to a specific topic and provides landowners the basic knowledge and skills needed to understand the soil, water, and plant resources on their property.

Participants will learn about:

- Developing property goals and plan
- Pasture and grassland management
- Weed identification and management
- Estate planning
- Windbreaks
- Watershed health
- Livestock basics
- Water rights
- Orchards and small fruit
- Reducing wildlife conflicts



This course will provide each participant information necessary to create a management plan suitable for their property. All of the resource information will help the landowners and land managers formulate achievable goals for their property designed to result in a sustainable grazing system for their animals or for wise management of natural landscapes.

Cost: \$60.00 per person and is limited to 30 total participants with a minimum of 10.
